## Clinician's Course Presenter: Dr. James Braun, DDS, MS

For more than 10 years Dr. Braun has offered seminars at national and international meetings. A native of Saginaw, Michigan he has a M.S. in Prosthodontics and D.D.S. from the University of Michigan.

### Creating Predictable Direct Composite Restorations Synopsis:

With the emphasis and financial need for direct esthetic dentistry, this seminar will focus on the very best dental materials and equipment used for successful placement of direct composite restorations. This lecture will cover avant-garde nano-tech composite systems and the latest generation of adhesive components. The adjunct of novel sectional matrices to enhance composite build-up will be advocated. The overall goal of this meeting is to improve clinical outcomes by refining skills and enhancing treatment protocol for these common procedures.

The hands-on portion will deal with placement of direct composites on typodonts utilizing the materials and the equipment highlighted in the lecture portion of the course.

This course is primarily intended for dentists, but clinical assistants are encouraged to attend.

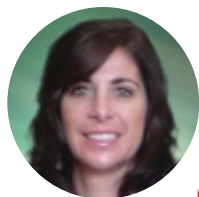


## EFDA Course Presenter: Theresa Groody, M.Ed., EFDA, CDA

Theresa has been practicing and teaching in the profession of Expanded Functions Dental Assisting for more than 30 years. She currently teaches Expanded Functions Lecture and Laboratory at Harcum College in Pennsylvania.

**ABC's of Direct Restorations Synopsis:** This course benefits both Chairsides and Expanded Function assistants. Basics of restorative procedures will be reviewed and discussed so the assistant will be able to work more efficiently and the EFDA to restore more competently. Every practice benefits from a more informed team member who can better educate and/or motivate patients into making clinical treatment decisions. Clinical tips and brand suggestions will be included.

Upon completion of the course, dental team members will be able to define adhesion and compare/contrast seven generations of dental adhesives. They will be able to explain the basic functions of etch, primer and bonding agent. Additionally, they will understand various matrix systems and have practiced matrix/wedge placement on typodonts.



## EFDA Course Presenter: Beth Walchuck, EFDA, CDA, BS

Beth has been in clinical practice for more than 14 years. She is Vice President of the Ohio Dental Expanded Functions Association and has considerable experience in both organizing and lecturing at CE events.

### Finishing and Polishing—Outstanding Results with Today's Composites Synopsis:

Direct composite resin materials have revolutionized the delivery of minimally invasive treatment in the posterior region. Contemporary resin formulations provide improved strength, wear resistance, and aesthetics. Microhybrid formulations have also been associated with enhanced polish ability. Development of an optimal surface polish in turn reduces stain and plaque accumulation, minimizes wear, and enhances the appearance of the definitive restoration.

Upon completion of this course, dental team members will understand the materials, techniques and protocol for finishing and polishing both anterior and posterior composite restorations. They will also understand the importance of correct finishing and polishing on plaque accumulation, stain resistance and wear resistance.

**Simplified Isolation Techniques Synopsis:** Proper isolation is critical to successful direct composite restorations, yet this step is sometimes overlooked. Armed with new knowledge, materials and techniques, dental team members can more rapidly and effectively isolate the restorative site and protect it from crevicular fluid contamination.

Upon completion of this course, dental team members will understand how contamination of the restorative site can adversely affect the long-term success of direct restorations. They will understand newer materials and techniques for achieving proper isolation and have practiced these skills on a typodont.
